

## MMSK Supply List for 2009-2010 School Year

**Community Supplies:** These items are to be shared with the community and should not be labeled.

- 10 two-pocket, solid color folders (with prongs for inserting papers) D0 NOT LABEL
- 1 roll of paper towels
- Fifty #2 pencils
- 2 packages of lined white index cards (3 ½” by 5”)
- Lined notebook paper (200 or more sheets)
- New scholars: 1 container of hand sanitizer and 1 box of kleenex (tissues)
- Returning scholars: 1 package of disposable forks, spoon, and knives

**Please be sure and bring in every item on the supply list on or before the first day of school – we will use many of these supplies on the first day as we set up planners and organize for the school year!!**

**Personal Supplies:** These items are used only by the scholars to whom they belong. **Please label each item (including individual makers).**

- Spiral notebook—8 ½” x 11” – 5 sections (dividers should have pockets) red for returning scholars, silver for new scholars
- Protractor and compass
- One bottle of rubber cement
- 3 hole – supply pocket to place in binder for holding pencils and supplies
- 1 tablet of bound graph paper ¼”
- One black and one blue pen for editing
- Two highlight markers
- Scissors
- 2 “Sharpie” fine point markers
- “Jump” drive for school to home use—**clearly label and place on lanyard – minimum 1GB**
- Library card
- Gardening gloves
- Old shoes or boots (that fit) that can get dirty—for work on the land
- A check payable to MMSK for \$70 to cover the cost of consumable workbooks (Spanish, journal, etc.), planner dividers and personal copies of paperback novels for Humanities
- Returning scholars only—a TI-83 or 83 plus calculator (you will also need these in high school—**please label both cover and calculator: etch name in both pieces**). The school has a few calculators to loan if this is a hardship for any family.
- A STURDY 3 ring binder to use for Daily Planner – **1 ½ inches**

**Backpacks:** If you choose to use a backpack please be mindful of the size since the fire code dictates that it must be stored inside the scholar’s locker at all times.

Returning students, if you have a Spanish workbook from last year, please bring it on the first day of school. Please return any text books that were previously issued to scholars.

**Supplies do not have to be new.** Please recycle and reuse whenever possible.

**Being prepared with needed supplies on a daily basis is essential for scholar success!**
