Thoughts on our Carpool Line from a Concerned Parent

One of the lessons we teach our kids is to learn the rules and follow them. If you are playing a game, it's best when everyone understands and follows the same set of rules so feelings don't get hurt. If you are driving a car, it's good to know the rules of the road so everyone stays safe and there aren't accidents.

At the beginning of the school year, we are instructed on how to pick up our children in the car line. There is a set of "rules" for lining up, and we all agree to abide by them for the safety of our children, courtesy to our school's neighbors, and the flow of traffic on our city streets. Periodically, we are given reminders by the school.

Lately, as I arrive to school, driving down Crestwood preparing to turn left into the school drive, I am faced with people turning right into the parking lot.
